The gathering expressed sincere appreciation to the **1974 batch** for taking a pioneering role in contributing to the **GENCO Alumni Association (GAA)**. With the encouragement and support of the our **Patron, Dr. Sehijpal Ji** it was unanimously agreed that the responsibility of strengthening the Alumni Association (GAA) rests collectively with all alumni.

The project involves the establishment of a dedicated innovation and collaboration workspace within the workshop area. The importance of timely **Income-Tax compliance** was also highlighted, and the successful filing of pending returns was acknowledged and unanimously agreed upon by the alumni present.
