

After passing out from GNEC in the year 1968, I started working as project Engineer with PWD (B&R) Government of Punjab.


From 1972 to 1988, I worked as Sub Divisional Engineer with PWD (PH) posted at Bathinda, Mohali and Ludhiana.


After graduation, I worked for almost two years in PWD (B&R) at Amritsar. Then I worked at Thermal Plant Bhatinda for two years.


THE SIXTIES

A lot was happening in India post Independence. Gujarat and Maharashtra were created out of Bombay State in 1960; Punjab was divided and Haryana came into existence in1966. After the death of two Prime Ministers, Jawaharlal Nehru in 1964 and Lal Bahadur Shastri in 1966, we got our first woman Prime Minister, Indra Gandhi.

India was involved in two wars; 1962 against China and 1965 against Pakistan. During the Indo-Pak war, some students from our batch, who were NCC Cadets, were on active duty guarding some key installations in Ludhiana.





In USA, President John F. Kennedy was assassinated in 1963, his brother Robert Kennedy in 1968. Martin Luther King Jr, civil rights leader, greatly influenced by Mahatma Gandhi, was assassinated in 1968.


1969 was the year when Neil Armstrong became the first man to set foot on the moon. Edwin Alldrin followed. Michael Collins continued to orbit in Apollo 11

After years of research, Philips developed the Compact Cassette in 1963.




We graduated in 1968, completing an important phase of our lives. Most of us searched for and secured jobs. Some of us decided to enhance our qualifications.

THE SEVENTIES

This was the decade where our ultimate futures were decided. We entered the fields we were to pursue in the long run. Further qualifications were acquired. Most of us got married during the 70s and shouldered the responsibilities of work and family. With the birth of children we realised how unprepared we were for this role. Indra Gandhi, the only woman Prime Minister of India, was known to be politically ruthless. She supported the independence movement in East Pakistan and engaged in a war with Pakistan in 1971. India was victorious and Bangladesh was created. India's stature rose and was considered a centre of power in South Asia. However, Mrs. Gandhi's decision to declare Emergency and suspend basic civil liberties and curb press freedom, was opposed nationwide.

Sikkim became India's 22nd state after a referendum was held.

Democracy was alive in India. In 1977, the ruling party lost and an alternative to the Congress emerged. Morarji Desai was sworn in as the first non Congress PM.

This period was witness to the Green Revolution. Productivity of food crops increased and Punjab became the granary of India. Operation Flood resulted in improving the rearing of livestock and enhancing milk production. India became self sufficient and ended food imports.



Mother Teresa (Saint Teresa now) was awarded the Nobel Prize for Peace in 1979. She dedicated her life to looking after the poor and destitute. She inspired many others.






Badminton took a major leap with Prakash Padukone (Father of Deepika Padukone), emerging as the Indian National Junior and Senior Champion in 1972. He remained so for the next seven years. He was the first Indian to win the Men's singles GOLD MEDAL at the 1978 Commonwealth Games.

Bollywood gave us some masterpieces during the seventies: Anand, Mera Naam Joker, Koshish, Deewar, Ankur, Bobby, Chupke Chupke, Sholay, Amar Akbar Anthony, Hare Rama Hare Krishna and so many more.

VHS, developed by JVC in the early 70s was released in Japan in 1976 and in the US in 1977. It had a long run of 41 yrs before giving way to newer technology.





THE EIGHTIES






India was euphoric and celebrating the first Cricket World Cup win in 1983. Against all odds, the team put in a magnificent performance under the captaincy of Kapil Dev, the boy from Chandigarh. In 1986 Gavaskar became the first batsman to score 10,000 runs.

The world of badminton was finally conquered in 1980 by Prakash Padukone, who became the first Indian to win the All England Open Championship. He went on to win three world championships.

P.T. Usha, the queen of track and field events, gave India many gold and silver medals at the Asian events but just missed the bronze in the L.A. Olympics in 1984.



Major reforms resulted in a boost for economic growth in India. Inflation was stable. The stock market saw a revival. The Open General License list was expanded.


Two tragic events mar this decade. Mrs Gandhi's assassination in 1984, followed by the anti-Sikh riots, is one of the saddest periods in our nation's history. So many innocent lives were lost. The second is the Bhopal Gas tragedy in December 1984.

Figures of casualties are not confirmed but thousands were injured and hundreds of deaths were reported. Many people are still suffering from the long term effects of the gas leak.

The mid 1980s saw the arrival of colour television in our country. It was a status symbol to own a colour TV during the early period. "NEIGHBOUR'S ENVY OWNER'S PRIDE"



India finally got on the list of Academy Award winners when Bhanu Athaiya won the Oscar for Best Costume in 1982 for the film Gandhi. This film won 8 Oscars, the first time an Indian story was on the winning podium.





From Hollywood to Bollywood. This decade gave us some exceptional films on serious topics. We had Masoom, Sadma, Saraansh, Ardh Satya, Parinda and Arth; full entertainment value from Jaane Bhi Do Yaaron and Mr India. Romance could not be forgotten, so we had Qayamat Se Qayamat Tak and Ek Duje Ke Liye. A silent film, Pushpak was released in 1987.

Infosys, the second largest IT company in India, was founded in 1981 in Pune but relocated to Bengaluru in 1983.

THE NINETIES

Sachin Tendulkar was on the way to becoming the God of Cricket. His phenomenal scoring began in this decade and continued well into the next one.





With so much happening during these 10 years, we had a grand Golden celebration of our Independence in 1997. India had come a long way, but still had more to do


THE NEW MILLENNIUM

During this first decade of the millennium, India suffered massive casualties due to two natural disasters. The Gujarat earthquake in 2001 resulted in over 30,000 deaths. The earthquake and tsunami at the end of 2004 devastated the southern coast of India and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. It brought havoc to 14 countries including Indonesia and Sri Lanka. The estimated death toll is 280,000.

India's peace and harmony was shattered very frequently in the years from 2001 to 2008. The suicide attack on Parliament in 2001, killed several security personnel. The 2002 Godhra massacre leading to inter religious bloodshed is still vivid in our memories. Bomb blasts in Mumbai, Delhi and Ahmedabad left more than 350 innocent people dead. Gunmen almost laid siege to the financial capital of India, Mumbai, in 2008, killing 200 and injuring hundreds.

Whether it is natural disasters or acts of terrorism, the Indian Armed Forces are always with us in the hour of crisis and lend a helping hand beyond the call of duty. A BIG SALUTE TO THEM.

In 2008 India launched its first mission to the moon - CHANDRAYAAN 1.



FM Radio: RADIO CITY was the first private FM radio station to broadcast from Mumbai in 2001. All major cities followed suit. We have approximately 250 FM stations now, and the number is growing.

The glorious time of sports in India had begun. In Test Cricket we achieved the No 1 rank. Sachin Tendulkar continued his run spree. In ODIs, the aggressive Captain, Saurav Ganguly, led the team to the finals of the World Cup in 2003. India was the winner of the first ICC World Twenty 20 Tournament held in 2007. We had a new Captain, the cool and calm M.S. Dhoni. It was in this tournament that Yuvraj Singh hit six sixes in one over in the match against England.



India's first individual Gold medal was won by Abhinav Bindra, (for 10 m air rifle shooting) in 2008 at the Beijing Olympics.

In 2005, Anju Bobby George, the long jump champion, won Gold at the IAAF World Athletics and Pankaj Advani became the World Billiards Champion. Viswanathan Anand won the World Chess Championship, while Geet Sethi won the Snooker World Title. In 2009, Saina Nehwal became the first Indian to win a Badminton Super Series Title.

Some brilliant films were released during this time. Amir Khan seems to be way ahead of all the others with Lagaan, Dil Chahta Hai, 3 Idiots, Tare Zameen Par and Rang De Basanti. We cannot forget the hugely entertaining Munnabhai MBBS and Jab We Met. Swades, The Legend of Bhagat Singh and Chak De India inspired patriotism. Some thought provoking films were A Wednesday, Dor, Iqbal and Company.

We, along with our son and daughter in law and three grandchildren, are living together in Patiala now.


