Having met each other after 50 years you would have seen time melt away and felt a togetherness mentioned by Guru Nanak Dev Ji.



Our Alumni have worked hard in the sun, not only sought by dint of their perspirational hard work, but also achieved places in the sun.




"Self-occupied" Gurpartap is a gentleman in the real sense. Fond of reading and indoor games, he maintains cordial relationships with one & all.
